 Amber Taverns Training and Development manager and HIT training tutors.
- The training programme will last approximately 6 months although it can sometimes vary depending on business needs and the speed of learning by the trainee.
- You will start off learning the basics and work your way through a structured training plan, having units signed off in your Amber Taverns training book.
- By the end you will have covered all aspects of running an Amber Taverns site. You will complete your training with a series of relief covers and final assessment.
- Each trainee will report to a dedicated Operator, be reviewed by their Area Manager and have additional support, guidance and mentoring from the Amber Taverns Training Manager.


